





Question 81

Answer

Grandville Stadium has been home to various events. It underwent an improvement project in 2019, hoping to elevate stadium hosting quality as well as attendance and eventually income. Based on the last attendance rates in 2017, a projection of the figures have been estimated in 2020 and 2030.

It has been estimated that the most popular events at the stadium, sporting events, will be visited by more than 150 thousand people in 2020 and almost 152 thousand in 2030. The projected figures do not indicate any drastic increase in attendance in sporting events. However, events related to concerts and theater have been estimated differently. While both theater and concert attendance seem to increase steadily and in smaller yet significant numbers in 2020, it is expected for the figures to increase dramatically in 2030. Theater attendance is expected to triple and concerts are predicted to host more than 110 thousand people in 2030 compared to the 25 thousand in 2017.

Overall, future attendance estimations are positive, with higher expectations for theater and concert events. Compared to these two categories, sporting events are not expected to change considerably in 2030. We will have to wait for the future to see whether these improvements were worth it.

Question 82**Answer**

Education is one of those areas where technology has made major improvements, while at times, affecting the process or the end product in a negative manner. It is not possible to deny that tablets and computers have facilitated the education process in various ways. Regardless, we need to make sure that the benefits outweigh the costs and think of ways to mitigate or if possible, avoid them.

The positive effects of the existence of laptops and tablets are many. These gadgets allow students access to the internet, where they can find more information quickly and with ease. They can also do research in a more efficient manner and spend less time going from one library to another, only to have access to local and national data and resources. At the same time, since grammar correction options are available, students do not pay enough attention to dictation. It appears that certain skills are deteriorating because of the existence of tablets and computers.

Even though these concerns are valid and noteworthy, the advantages of having computers in schools are much more than the issues to which they have led. These problems can be addressed and mitigated by teachers trying to balance the use of computers. The balancing act will be in the teachers' shoulders.
